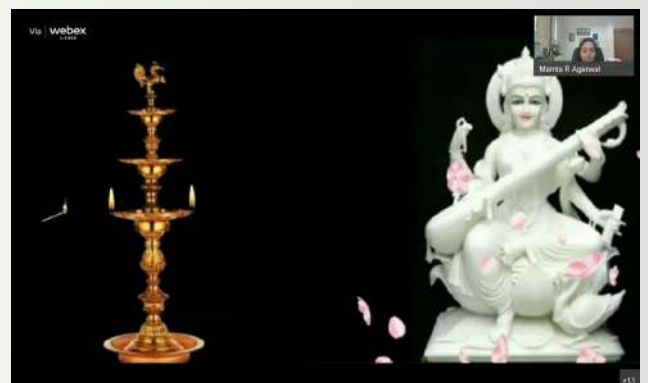
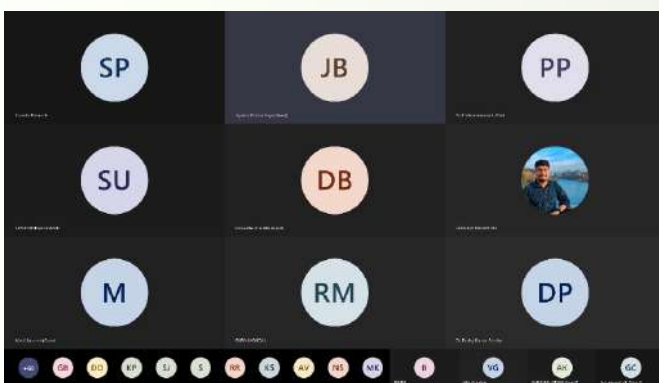

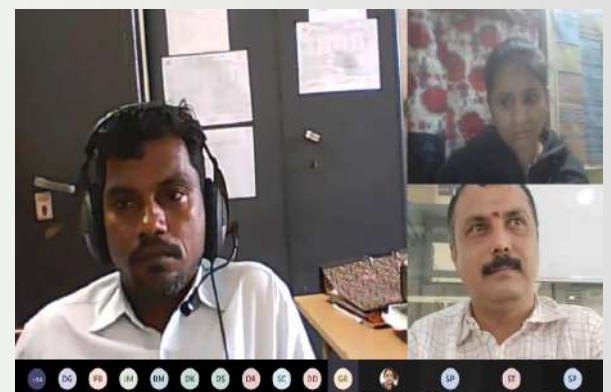
ATAL WORKSHOP on GREEN TECHNOLOGY AND SUSTAINABILITY

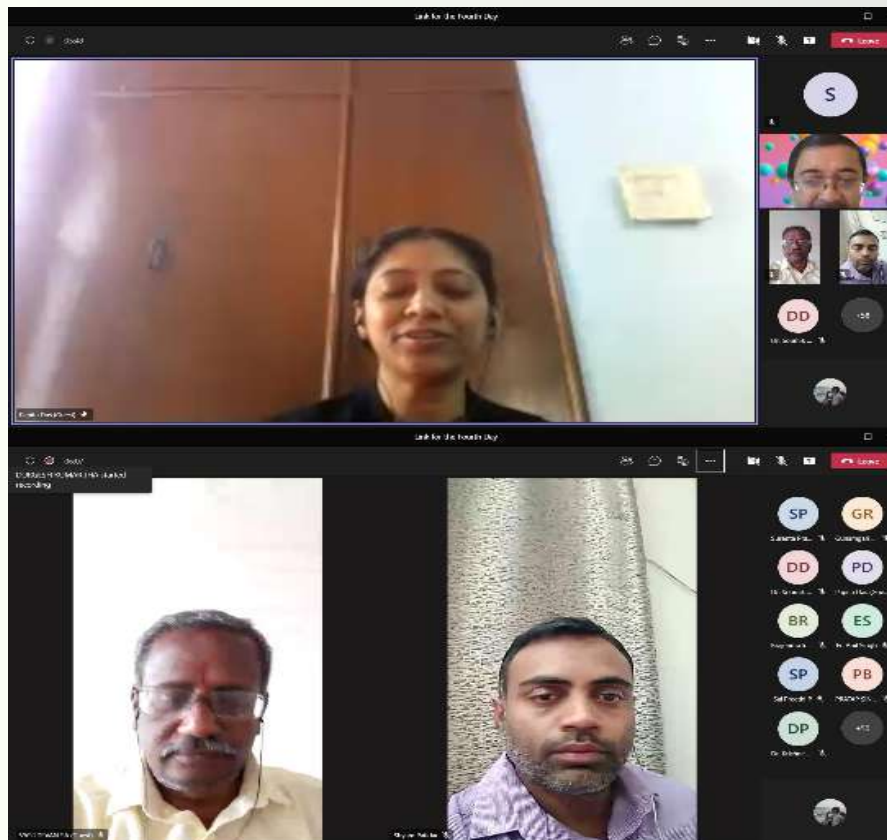

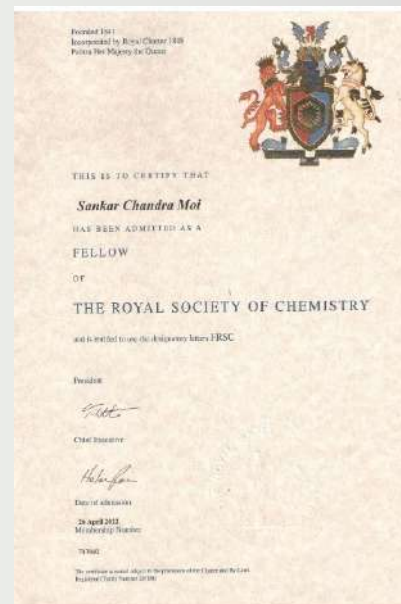
